**2012 Mas Cal Demoura Terrasses  
du Larzac les Combariolles**

A step up from the l'infidele (in price as well), the 2012 Terrasses du Larzac Les Combariolles is made from 40% Syrah, 40% Mourvèdre, 15% Carignan and small splash of Grenache. Brought up all in 500-600-liter demi-muids (25% new), it has a modern ting to its crème de cassis, blackberry, crushed flowers, spice and creamy vanilla aromatics. This is followed by a full-bodied, seamless 2012 that has superb mid-palate depth, fine tannin and a blockbuster finish. It's superb on all accounts, and should have a decade or more of overall longevity.

This is another great producer from one of the top appellations in the Languedoc, the Terrasses du Larzac. You can see more information on the estate in my write up in Issue 212, but these wines are made by Isabelle and Vincent Goumard, who purchased the estate from Jean-Pierre Julien (who's the father of Mas Julien's Olivier Julien) in 2004. These are first rate wines.

**2012 Mas Cal Demoura Terrasses  
du Larzac Feu Sacre**

A blend of 70% Grenache, 20% Carignan and 10% Syrah aged in older demi-muid, the 2012 Terrasses du Larzac Feu Sacre is a smoking effort that will give many a Chateaufort du Pape a run for its money. Kirsch, blackberry, licorice, incense and dried flowers all come together beautifully, and this full-bodied effort has a rounded, sexy, supple profile that's hard to resist. Drink it any time over the coming 5-8 years.

**2012 Mas Cal Demoura Terrasses  
du Larzac l'Infidele**

The entry level 2012 Terrasses du Larzac l'Infidele is a blend of 30% Syrah, 25% Mourvèdre, 20% Grenache, 15% Carignan and the balanced Cinsault. Completely destemmed, vinified in stainless steel and concrete tanks, and aged 12 months in 15% new demi-muids, it's a complete, balanced red that offers lots of currants and assorted dark fruits, smoked earth, licorice and subtle barrique characteristics. Medium to full-bodied, with terrific purity and length, it's a classy effort that represent a good value.
